Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

Ran 68 joints (2046') 9-5/8" OD 36# Grade J-55 Seamless Steel Casing and 45 joints (1382') 9-5/8" OD 32.30# Grade H-40 Seamless Steel Casing. Set and cemented at 3419' in 2 stages with a total of 1828 sacks Incon Cement. First stage with 828 sacks 4% Gel and 100 sacks regular neat cement on bottom. Opened DV tool at 1603' and circulated approximately five sacks. Second stage through DV tool with 900 sacks 4% Gel. Circulated approximately 20 sacks. Plug at 3416', maximum pressure 600#. Job completed at 3:00 AM 7-15-58.

After waiting over 30 hours, tested 9-5/8" casing with 1,000# for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilled through DV tool at 1603' and tested with 1,000# for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug and tested with 1,000# for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure.
