DST #2 - 6970-7020' (Silurian) Thru 4 1/2" DP, 1" surface choke, 5/8" bottom choke. Gas to surface in 8 minutes, TSTM. No fluid to surface. Reversed out 52 bbls 40 gravity oil & 10% Oil & gas cut mud, out 10% oil, no water. Recovered 20' oil, no water below circ sub. HP 3206#. FP 985-2020#. 30 minute BUP 2422#.

DST #3 - 7385-7485' (Montoya) Thru 4 1/2" DP, 1" surface choke, 5/8" bottom choke. Tool opened with weak blow air throughout test. Recovered 268' fluid, 120' trace oil with gas cut mud and 148' sulphur water. HP 3740#. FP 162-245#. 30 minute BUP 2800#.
