8-5/8" 32# 8-Thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 1007' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 300 sacks. Job completed 2:30 P.M. 10/12/37.

The casing will be allowed to stand undisturbed for 72 hours. The casing and connections will then be tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results the cement will then be drilled out of the casing and the same test of 1200# pump pressure will again be applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results the drilling will then be resumed.
