Dear Sir:

We are filing the attached Form C-110 to indicate the above well is not connected to an authorized transporter of casing head gas. This well was completed in the Blinbry pay and produced into the central commingled battery. The pipe line transporter classified this crude sour and we therefore, constructed a separate battery for this well's production. On November 13, 1961, Permian Corporation connected to the new battery and we are working with El Paso Natural Gas Company to obtain a physical connection in the near future for the sale of casinghead gas.
