Pld dual completion assembly. Ran Baker latching type DR plug & set in 415-D pkr @ 5763'. Spotted 17 sk common cmt plug on top of 415-D pkr from 5763-5646. Job complete @ 10:30 PM 9/23/68. Tubb/Drinkard zone now abandoned. Added Blinebry perfs @ 5259, 5268, 5280, 5289, 5303, 5312, 5326, 5337, 5347, 5357, 5363 & 5366 w/one 1/2 JS. Treated all Blinebry perfs down 3-1/2" tbg w/43848 gallons of slick fresh water containing 42500# of 20/40 sand. Frac'd in 5 stages using rock salt in saturated brine between stages to act as diverting agent. Preceded each frac stage w/500 gallons 15% HCl acid. AIR 20 BPM @ 2800#. ISIP 800#. Job complete 9/25/68. Ran Blinebry completion assembly of 2-3/8" tbg, bottomed @ 5230'. Swabbed well in. On 24 hr test ending @ 8:00 AM 9/29/68 flowed 218 BO & 17 BLW. Well is now single Blinebry producer.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 41. If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
