DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Bridging plug was set at 3100' and casing perforated from 2773' to 3000' - 596 holes - resulting in no commercial production of gas. Test of casing revealed leak at 1192' and same was squeezed off and test of job showed that no further leaks existed. All perforations were then squeezed. Bridging plug was drilled and well cleaned out to 3416', resulting in daily production test of 18 bbls. Well will be put on production as soon as necessary lifting equipment has been installed.
