DETAILS OF WORK

Plugging was completed December 29, 1952, with cement plugs set at the following intervals: 3140' 20 sx. cement; 1300' 20 sx. cement. Surface 20 sx. cement. All intervals filled with heavily mud laden fluid. Approximately 1300' - 7" casing was recovered. A 4" pipe abandonment marker was erected and the location leveled to conform with the original contour of the land.
