DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was drilled in 1936 to a total depth of 3413' PBTD 3409'. Production declined steadily from the initial potential of 50 BOPD. In March, 1937 this well was shot with 120 quarts SNG and cleaned cut. Production stabilized at approximately 14 BOPD for one year then declined to nothing. The above well has been shut in since December 1942. We propose to plug and abardon P. J. Langlie "B" #1 as follows:

Shoot off and pull approximately 2100! 7" casing. Spot 20 sack cement plugs at the following depths: 3409! (PBTD); 3140! (Base of 7" csg); 2100! (Top of 7" stub); 504! (Base of Surface Pipe); and at surface. The above intervals are to be filled with a heavy mud. A 4" pipe abandonment marker will be erected and the location leveled to conform with existing regulations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Goological Survey before operations may be commenced.
