

HISTORY OF OIL OR GAS WELL

It is of the greatest importance to have a complete history of the well. Please state in detail the dates of redrilling, together with the reasons for the work and its results. If there were any changes made in the casing, state fully, and if any casing was "sidetracked" or left in the well, give its size and location. If the well has been dynamited, give date, size, position, and number of shots. If plugs or bridges were put in to test for water, state kind of material used, position, and results of pumping or bailing.

The well was shot with 100 lbs. of 2 1/2" Nitro-Glycerin from 3334-3412, on October 28th, 1933. After clearing hole, found water. Cleaned out, and ran steel line measurement, found bottom of hole at 3412'. Started plugging back with lead wool on November 1, 1933, and plugged back from 3412 to 3400', filled with Red Gravel from 3400 to 3412', and ran steel cuttings from 3331 to 3333'. Drilled out lead plug to 3400'. No gas-oil was collected. 3" tubing was run with perforations at 3333'. After 6 days, well made 20 barrels per day thru 1 1/2" choke, no water. Gas/oil ratio of 3333 3/4.

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
