DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

It is our plan to change the casing program from three string, as shown on our Notice of Intention to Drill dated August 4th, to a two string program.

We intend to use 500' of 10-3/4" casing set in the red rock and cemented to surface. 7" oil string to be set at approximately 3160' in brown lime and cemented.

* Approved as an experimental exception with understanding that future two string approvals will be based on results of this job, and that the salt section will be drilled with saturated salt solution. The method of placing salt in holes made in circulating mud or water which prior to drilling salt, and maintaining same, will be 3.0% (approx.) and will be increased as much as practical.
