Casing was cemented at bottom, using 160 sacks of cement, which brought the cement more than 200 feet above the casing shoe. The upper stage was cemented at depth of 980 feet, using 188 sacks of cement, bringing the cement above the bottom of the surface string. Casing will be tested for water shut-off on June 27, 1937.
