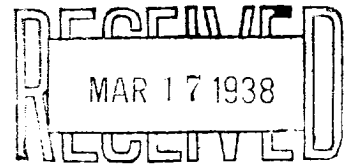

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut-off, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the Commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was cemented with a two-stage cement job.
5-1/2 OD casing cemented at depth of 3150 feet; two-stage
cement collar at 980 feet. After allowing cement to stand
48 hours, top plug was drilled and tested with 1000 pounds
pressure, valves closed, and allowed to stand for 30 minutes.
Test was satisfactory as pressure did not drop more than
100 pounds during the period. Bottom plug was drilled and
similarly tested, proving to be satisfactory.
