Form C-104 is to be submitted in QUADRUPLICATE to the same District Office to which Form C-104 is sent. The allowable will be assigned effective 7:00 A.M. on date of completion or recompletion, provided this form is filed within the calendar month of completion or recompletion. The completion date shall be that date in the case of an oil well when the oil is pumped into the stock tanks. Gas must be reported on 15.025 psia at 60° Fahrenheit.
