After waiting 48 hours, tested D. V. plug and 5 1/2" csg. with 1000# for 1/2 hour - no drop in pressure. Drilled D. V. plug at 10:30 a.m. 1-30-51. Tested D. V. tool and 5 1/2" csg. with 1000# - no drop in pressure. Drilled bottom plug and pressure tested 5 1/2" csg. and cement job - OK. After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil & Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
