DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 135 jts. 3157.80' of 5-1/2" OD 17# Lapweld ST&C Csg. w/3 Weatherford Centralizers & 12 Weatherford Scratchers from 3168-3019! Howco DV cementing Tool at 1139', Cemented in two stages with 300 sax. Casing set at 3169'. First stage cemented w/75 sax Neat cement on bottom. Max. pressure 800#. Second stage thru DV tool at 1139', cemented w/125 sax 4% Gel & 25 max Neat cement on bottom. Max. Press. 400#. Cir. approx. 15 sax cement.

After waiting over 24 hrs., tested w/1500# for 30 min. No drop in pressure. Drilled cement & plug from 3142' to 3169'.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to complete well.
