Well spudded January 3, 1949.

Top of red bed section encountered at 66'. 10-3/4" 40# seamless casing set at 83' (17' in red beds) and cemented to surface by Halliburton with 50 sac on January 4, 1949. Allowed to set 36 hours. Plug drilled January 6, 1949, hole bailed dry and drilling resumed. (No water was encountered above red bed section).
