

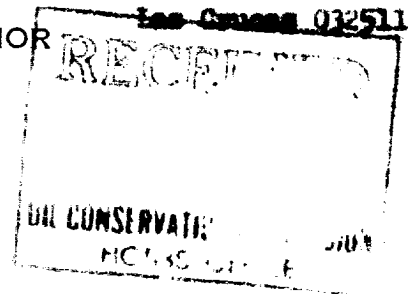

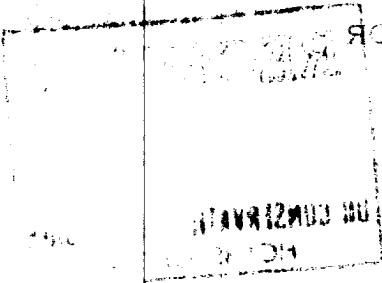

1. Drilling operations as authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Sufficient cement must be used behind the 9 5/8" casing to reach the surface.
3. Sufficient cement must be used in cementing through 2-stage tool at approximately 1100' to reach the surface.
