In Re: Application of Jal Oil Company, Inc. for Administrative Approval of an 80 acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool for the Jal Oil Company, Inc. Harner No. 2 well which is located in the NW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

Jal Oil Company, Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R-520, as amended, of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit of 80 acres, more or less, comprising the W/2 of the SE/4 of Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. That Jal Oil Company, Inc. holds the gas operating rights under the W/2 of the SE/4 of Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, down to a depth of 4,000 feet and Jal Oil Company, Inc. is operator of said tract of land.
2. That Jal Oil Company, Inc. has dually completed the Jal Oil Company, Inc. Harner No. 2 well as a gas well producing from the Jalmat Gas Pool and as an oil well producing from the Langlie-Mattix Oil Pool. That said well is located 660 feet from the North and 585 feet from the East boundary lines of said tract and was drilled to a total depth of 3440'.

1. The first step in the process of the development of the new system is the selection of the personnel who will be responsible for the implementation of the system. This selection process should be based on the following criteria:

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3. That the location of the Jal Oil Company, Inc. Harner No. 2 well is an unorthodox location due to topographical conditions consisting of the proximity of this well location to the City of Jal, New Mexico and certain residential dwellings in or near said city.
4. That the proposed Non-Standard Proration Unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of Order R-520, as amended, in that the proposed unit consists of two contiguous quarter-quarter sections within a single governmental section, that the length or width thereof does not exceed 5,280 feet, and that the entire area of the proposed unit lies within the horizontal limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool and may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That by a copy of this Letter of Application, all of the other operators owning an interest in the section in which the proposed Non-Standard Proration Unit is situated and all operators owning an interest within 1,500 feet of the well have by registered mail been notified.
6. That a plat showing the acreage to be dedicated to the proposed Non-Standard Proration Unit, the location of the said well and the offset ownership is attached hereto.
7. Jal Oil Company, Inc. wishes to advise the Commission that it is its intention to use this well as the unit well.

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and in compliance with the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R-520, as amended, Jal Oil Company, Inc. requests Administrative approval of said proposed forty acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit, and Jal Oil Company, Inc. further requests Administrative approval of the unorthodox location of the Jal Oil Company, Inc. Harner No. 2 well.
