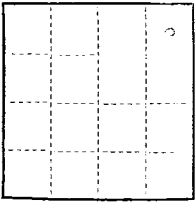

DETAILS OF WORK

5-21-54 to 6-1-54: Ran 5-1/2" liner, cemented out hole to 355', ran 5-1/2" liner to 365'. Cemented in with 100 sacks. Treated well with 6,000 gals. cement from 365' to 355'. After load oil recovered, well flowed approximately 45 bbls and 75,000 cu ft.

6-1-54 to 6-1-54: Increased production from 45 bbls to 100 bbls.
