Gentlemen:

Answering your letter of September 27, Ajax Drilling Corporation and Anderson-Prichard Oil Corporation, both as principals, with American Employers' Insurance Company as surety, have a \$5,000.00 drilling bond to cover one ten-acre tract in the above designated forty-acre legal subdivision. The tract covered by the bond in question is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township
25 S., Range 37 East.

That well, according to the last report filed in this office, was not complete on August 16, 1937.

Possibly the location you have in mind is still another subdivision of the above forty-acre tract. You should inquire of the applicant exactly the facts. That is, whether the well you have in mind is on a ten-acre spacing and if so, which of the four ten-acre tracts within the above designated forty-acre tract.
