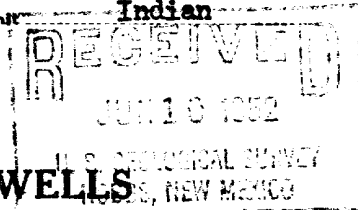

DETAILS OF WORK

TD 3007'. Rigged up pulling unit on 5-22-52. Filled hole with 10.5# mud. Spotted 30 sacks cement from 2984' to 2730'. 5 1/2" casing was not free when shot at 1150' and 1000', but did become free when shot at 900'. Pulled 916' overall of 5 1/2" casing. Spotted 11 sacks cement from 933' to 883'; 16 sacks cement from 304' to 354'; and 5 sacks cement from 0' to 12'. Plugging completed on 5-26-52.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

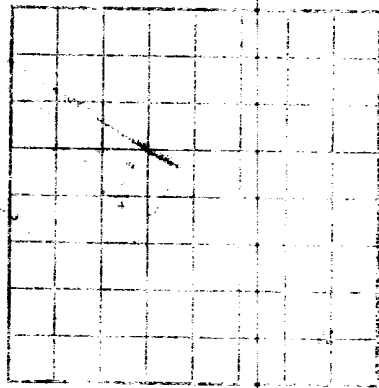
