Certificate

The undersigned A. R. Effenaar hereby certifies application for approval of a non-standard gas production unit comprising 1/2 NW/4 and the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 22, T28N-R, R28E-S, 120 acres, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) A. R. Effenaar is the owner and operator of oil and gas leases known as the F. S. S. Stuart and F. S. S. Stuart Community in the above recited section, and as shown on the attached plat.
- (2) A. R. Effenaar proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 120 acre gas production unit in compliance with Rule 5 (a) of Order 2-288.
- (3) The F. S. S. Stuart 120 Acre Gas Production Unit lies between the East 1/2 NW/4 NW/4 and the North 1/2 NW/4 NW/4 of Section 22, T28N-R, R28E-S, Lea County, New Mexico, has completed in the latter part of a gas well on December 27, 1956. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (4) The proposed non-standard gas production unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Regulations Order No. 2-288 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit may contain within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be expected to be productive of gas.

(a) The length of term of the proposed unit shall not exceed 1000 feet.

(b) (Amended)

(c) A. B. Spenser is authorized operator of all the savings comprising the proposed unit as shown on the attached plat, and by way of this letter of application, all operations during interval in the section in which the proposed unit is located and the operations within 1000 feet of the proposed unit shall be controlled by registered land of the State of A. B. Spenser to form the proposed unit, gas provision unit.

(d) The approval of this Commission for a unit and associated gas provision unit will, in the opinion of this applicant, provide water, protect own relative rights and serve the best interests of preservation.

In view of the substance of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Article 1 of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. 1936, A. B. Spenser requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above proposed associated gas provision unit.

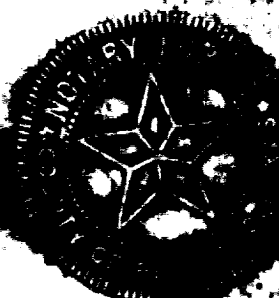
