DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED  
 Cleaned out to bottom, drilled from 3368-3399, shot 170 qts NG 3227-3316, filled hole pea gravel 3399-3316; shot bridged, gas broke thru but did not clean out. Cleaned out with sand pump and tools to 3393, hole making some water. Halliburton ran Cal-seal plug 3371-3366, cleaned out, making 50% water. Drilled out Cal-seal, ran steel cutting and lead wool plug at 3379 from 3369, lead wool 3365 to 3369. Tested for 72 hours and reduced water from 25% to 1.8% at end of test. Hole cleaned up, no water, oil showing 1/10 to 2/10 BS&W. Well making 20 bbls daily. Tubing hung at 3279.
