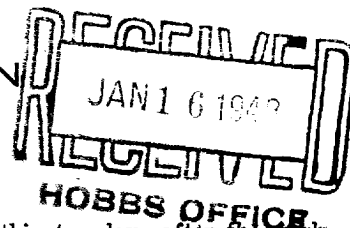

tamp and oil load from 3310 to 3345, cleaned out bottom TD 3394,  
3310 3345

re-ran tubing to 3360. Put well on potential test at 9 pm 1-10-48  
for 24 hours, completed 9 pm 1-11-48 and well produced 115 barrels  
oil and 1,451,000 of gas, gas oil ratio of 12,608 to 1.  
Please grant increased allowable as result of this workover and notify  
Shell Pipeline Corporation.
