Dear Mr. Stogner:

This letter will supplement our original letter dated October 16, 1997, and our telephone conversation on October 21, 1997 concerning the above captioned request.

Permian Resources, Inc. ("Permian") is the operator of the following well which currently produces out of the Langlie Mattix Queen zone:

Harrison #3, 1650' FSL, 1650' FWL Section 22, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico Perforations/Production: 3275-3377/ Langlie Mattix Pool Completed 9/15/38

This current Langlie Mattix zone has become marginal to operate. The company has identified potential gas pay in the upper Yates-Seven Rivers zones and would like to re-complete from that zone. This recompletion will require a new pool classification to the Jalmat Gas Pool, an unorthodox location exception, and a non-conforming acreage/spacing order.

Jalmat Gas Pool rules call for a 640-acre proration unit. Permian is asking the Oil Conservation Commission to amend that rule for a Non-Standard Proration Unit to encompass the 80 acres it owns as highlighted on the accompanying C-102. That proration unit will encompass the acreage below.

As indicated on my previous correspondence we have notified all current active Jalmat Gas Pool operators in the surrounding contiguous sections and included a list for your review.

There are 4 active Jalmat Gas Pool operators in Section 22. These are listed below with their OCD numbers:

- Prime Operating #1(F) Mobil, 1980' FNL, 2180' FWL, NSP-R-8254 for 150 Acres, E/2 NW/4, NW/4 NE/4, and W/30 acres NE/4 NE/4 Perforations 2805-2965
- F&M Oil & Gas #2(N) Carlson Federal, 990' FSL, 2310' FWL, NSP-1297 for 80 acres, W/2 SW/4 Perforations: 2822-2970
- 3. Prime Operating #1(D) Lanehart, 660' FWL, 660' FNL, NSL-2340 for 160 acres, W/2 NW/4 of Section 22 and E/2 NE/4 Section 21. Perforations: 2900-3040
- Burlington #1(L) Carlson Federal, 1980' FSL, 660' FWL
 200 acres, No Orders Found, W/2 SW/4 of Section 22, Units D, E, and F of Section 27
 Perforations: 2822-2940

Burlington #2(L) Carlson Federal, 1650' FSL, 660' FWL 200 acres, No Orders Found, W/2 SW/4 of Section 22, Units D, E, and F of Section 27. Perforations: 2885-3267

All dedicated acreage is shown on the Form C-102 plat as reflected in a recent record check at the Hobbs District office done on October 24, 1997. As you can see there have been 2 Non-Standard Prorations Units in Section 22.

All Jalmat Gas Pool field operators that are contiguous to Section 22 have been notified in writing of this request. A list is provided for your review.

We appreciate your timely review of this matter since we would like to begin work on this well to satisfy time and work commitments which have been submitted to the BLM and OCD.
