Re: Application for Dual (Tubingless) Completion, A. B. Coates "C" Well No. 24,
Unit H, Section 24, T25S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

In accordance with my recent telephone conversation with Mr. Daniel S. Nutter, certain data pertaining to the reservoir and fluid characteristics of the Justis-Blinebry, Tubb-Drinkard, Fusselman, Montoya, McKee and Ellenburger Pools are attached. It is hoped that these data include sufficient information to allow the Commission to determine the pools for which applications for administrative approval of multiple completion will be accepted. It would be greatly appreciated if the Commission would issue a memorandum for the Justis Field similar to the one issued on July 10, 1962, for the North Justis Field.

Also attached is Tidewater's Application for Dual Completion for its A. B. Coates "C" Well No. 24. It is proposed to complete this well as a tubingless dual in the Justis Blinebry and Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pools. It is anticipated that both zones will be oil completions and will flow initially.

It is respectfully requested that Tidewater be granted administrative approval for this application if the Commission finds, after reviewing the attached data, that the Blinebry and Tubb-Drinkard Pools are eligible for this approval.
