2. Cement behind the 9-5/8" casing must cover the Salt section as determined by temperature survey.

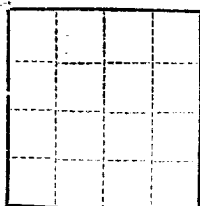

Well to be drilled to approximately 9700' or through the Devonian Expected Production Oil.

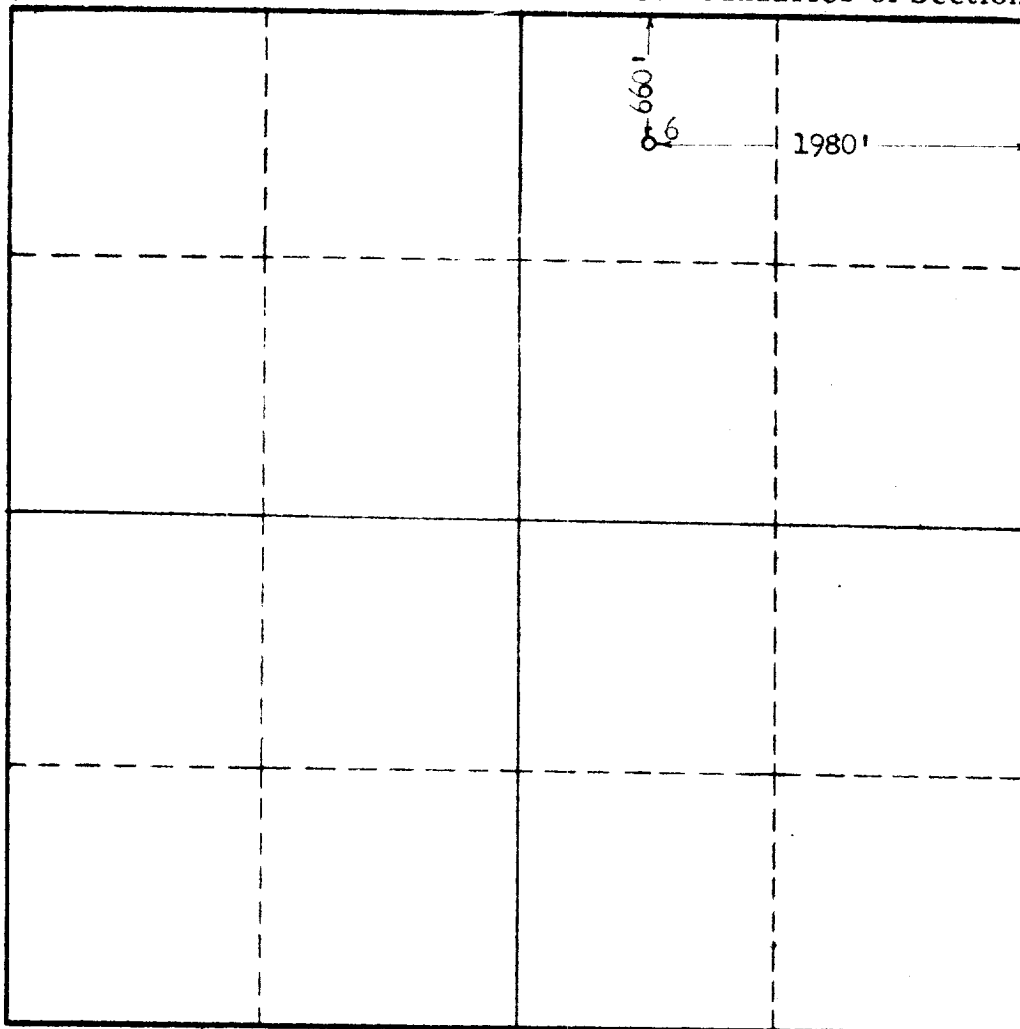
