The well is currently producing from the Montoya Zone with a production rate of 1 BOPD.

It is proposed to recomplete in the Blinebry Zone as follows: Run cement bond log and squeeze cement casing if log warrants. Perforate selected intervals in the Blinebry from 5024 to 5497' with one shot per foot - a total of 43 shots. Set a CIBP at 5850'. Treat Blinebry perforations with 80,000 gals. gelled water carrying 120,000# sand. Treatment will be down 3" frac tubing with a packer set at 4800'.

Upon a successful completion in the Blinebry, the Montoya Zone is to be temporarily abandoned.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, as indicated, on all types of lands and leases for appropriate action by either a Federal or a State agency, or both, pursuant to applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 1: If the proposal is to redrill to the same reservoir at a different subsurface location or to a new reservoir, use this form with appropriate notations. Consult applicable State or Federal regulations concerning subsequent work proposals or reports on the well.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 14: Needed only when location of well cannot readily be found by road from the land or lease description. A plat, or plats, separate or on this reverse side, showing the roads to, and the surveyed location of, the well, and any other required information, should be furnished when required by Federal or State agency offices.
