This well is a triple completion in the Ellenburger, Tubb-Brinkard, and Kincaid Zones. There is communication between the Tubb-Brinkard and Ellenburger Zones making it necessary to pull and repair same. A similar leak occurred in March, 1969 at which time the repair cost approximately \$10,000. The Tubb-Brinkard is making only 6 BOPD; therefore, it is proposed to temporarily abandon the Tubb-Brinkard behind 2 packers and inhibit this troublesome annular area, while the leak is being repaired. The Tubb-Brinkard will be re-evaluated after the Ellenburger Zone is depleted.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
