Well is dually completed in the McKee and Ellenburger formations. At present the Ellenburger zone is producing 60 BOPD, while the Mc Kee Zone is MIO. It is proposed to squeeze off the Mc Kee perforations; plugback the Ellenburger zone and complete the well as a single as follows:

1. Run retrievable BP and RTTS. Set BP at 7250', test w/3000#, spot 10' sand on top of BP. Squeeze off Mc Kee perforations 7152-70' with 100 sacks Class "C" with 0.5% CFA-2 and 3# salt/sack. WOC 24 hours. Drill out cement and pressure test the squeezed off Mc Kee perforations to 2000#. Retrieve the bridge plug.
2. Run Baker packer picker, etc., mill over the Model "D" packer @ 7350' and retrieve. Set 4-1/2" cement retainer at 7710'. Pressure up casing-tubing annulus to 2000# to test top of 4-1/2" liner.
3. Squeeze off Ellenburger perforations 7741-47' with 100 sacks of Class "H" cement w/ 0.5% Haled 9, and 3# sand/sack.
4. Spot 50 gals. acid from 7675' to 7600'. Perforate the Ellenburger zone @ 7643', 44, 45, 46, 49, 50, 53, 54, 55, 57, 58, and 59' with one JSPD. Run 2-1/8" tubing with 7" Lok-set packer and set packer at approximately 7300'. Acidize Ellenburger perforations with 500 gals. 15% HX PE Acid using ball sealers. Swab well to flowing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
