Receipt is acknowledged of "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated May 9, 1942 covering your well No. 1-D Centes located on subject land in SE1/4, section 24, T. 25S, R. 37E, Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be furnished upon request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Cement behind the 7" casing should extend about 200 feet above the top of the Salado salt section, as determined by a temperature survey to be made within 12 hours after completion of the cement job.
