2. *Staphylococcus aureus* (ATCC 12228) was grown in tryptic soy broth (TSB) (Difco) supplemented with 0.5% yeast extract (Difco) and 0.5% glucose (Difco) at 37°C. Cells were harvested at mid-log phase (OD₆₀₀ = 0.5) and washed with 100 mM NaCl, 10 mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.4, 1 mM EDTA, 1 mM EGTA, 1 mM DTT, and 0.1% Triton X-100 (TBS). Cells were then resuspended in 100 mM NaCl, 10 mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.4, 1 mM EDTA, 1 mM EGTA, 1 mM DTT, and 0.1% Triton X-100 (TBS) and lysed by sonication. Cell debris was removed by centrifugation at 14,000g for 10 min. The supernatant was then dialyzed into 100 mM NaCl, 10 mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.4, 1 mM EDTA, 1 mM EGTA, and 0.1% Triton X-100 (TBS) and stored at 4°C.
