Drilled to 465' and ran 15 joints of 8-5/8" O.D. casing. Total 453.08' set at 464.08', set with 314 sacks of Lone Star regular neat cement. Cement circulated. Plug down @ 2:30 AM 11-8-56. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes OK. Drilled cement plug and pumped into formation with 400#.
