Gentlemen:

Soon after the granting of permission to co-mingle production from the Blinebry and Tubb formations from a lease consisting of the S/2, SE/4 of Section 25, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Lea Jounty, New Mexico and before an oil shipping connection was received, the oil from the Blinebry formation was found to be sour crude. We, therefor, connected our Blinebry well to a sour crude line and our Tubbs well to a sweet crude line and we are not co-mingling the oil from the existing well, Carlson B 25 No. 2.

The other Blinebry wells in the Justis Pool are sweet oil and we presume that this should govern the co-mingling of oils in any future wells on this lease dually completed in Tubbs-Blinebry.
