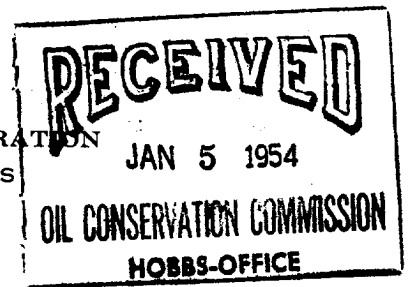

to Rule 4 is being requested.

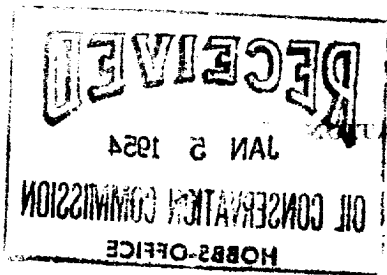
