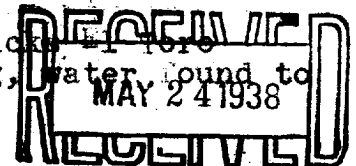

The Commission is composed of representatives from various countries, including the United States, the United Kingdom, and the Soviet Union.

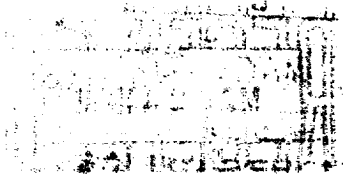
