Plugged Back Depth 2495'

Pump hole full heavy mud through 2 1/2" tubing and set 18 sack cement bridge in 7" OD casing. Shoot off 7" OD casing and pull keeping hole full heavy mud. Set 10 sack cement bridge at approximately 1150 ft., keeping hole full heavy mud, to bottom of collar. Set piece of 4" pipe in bottom of collar in 5 sack cement to extend 4' above surface level for "Regulation Marker". Fill collar & level location.
