FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Preparing to abandon well and recover as much 7", 8-5/8", 13" OD Casing that might be recovered with a Casing pulling machine. We intend to cement up in 7" casing and shoot casing loose. Fill hole with mud and plug bottom 12" casing and shoot pipe. Will place cement plug from 3061' to 2800' using 50 sacks cement. Will place cement plug at 2709' using 10 sacks cement. Will cement 4" marker extending 8' above the surface with 10 sacks cement. Hole will be filled with mud from 2709' to surface.
