DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

We propose to drill this test with rotary tools from surface to total depth of approximately 3200'. Contract for this work has been let to Baker & Taylor.

We will cement 10-3/4" 32# casing in a 15" hole at depth of about 300 feet and circulate cement back into cellar. We will cut an 8-3/4" hole below surface casing and run 7" casing for a pay string. Pay string will be cemented with shoe set on bottom and will be cemented by a two-stage process using 150 sacks on bottom and 150 sacks through the two-stage tool at 1050 feet. Cement will be allowed the set time required by regulations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
