Gentlemen:

On May 7, 1957 this office advised you that due to the gas-oil ratio on your Gregory "A" Well No. 22-N in Section 31, T-25-S, R-37-E, Jalmat Gas Pool being in excess of 100,000 to 1 that the well would be reclassified as a gas well. However, your gas-oil ratio test of March 31, 1957 indicates that the ratio is now 98,450 to 1.

This well will remain in the Oil Schedule in view of this latest test.
