Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the E/2 of Section 32, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of a 640-acre oil and gas lease known as the Arnott-Ransay "B" State Lease, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 320-acre gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5(a) of Order R-520.
- (3) The Arnott-Ransay "B" Well No. 2, located 660 feet from the east line and 1980 feet from the north line, Section 32, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed on October 24, 1955, as a gas-oil dual well. This well is in the Jalmat Gas Pool and the Langlie-Mattix Oil Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (4) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

Oil Conservation Commission hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas tract consisting of 350 acres located in Section 32, T-2S-R-5, Lee County, Texas, and in support thereof states the following facts:

(1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of a 640-acre oil and gas lease known as the "Arnot-Dean" "B" State Lease, Lee County, Texas, as shown on the attached plat.

(2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 350-acre gas tract with an exception to Rule 5(a) of Order 1-520.

(3) The Arnot-Dean "B" well No. 2, located 600 feet from the east line and 150 feet from the north line, Section 32, T-2S-R-5, Lee County, Texas, was completed on October 22, 1952, as a 350-foot well. This well is in the latest gas pool and the Langhite-Salt Oil Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.

(4) The proposed non-standard gas tract will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order 1-520 as follows:

(a) Conditions prescribed herein meet as well as those the unit.

(b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
