DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well Acidized With 1000 gallons of 60% Hydrochloric Acid Solution # 3 Gallons #2 HEP Inhibitor. The chemical was pumped into the well thru the tubing and followed up with 18 barrels of water. Work done by the Chemical Process Co.

Well made 90% water and unable to get test before treatment.

After treatment well made 71 barrels oil and 77 barrels of water, swabbing. Did not make enough gas to flow the well.
