DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 3244'. Tubing was cleaned out to bottom and cut off with Bangs Ross Tool 6 or 8 feet above circulating tool. Lane-Wells Co. perforated the 5 1/2" casing with 24 holes from 3128' to 3151'. 2" tubing was run and set at 3207'. Material left in hole: 1-2" Otis Removable bottom hole choke; 10' of 2" tubing and Halliburton Reverse Circulating tool. Overall measurement of tubing and tool is 16'. Same were pulled up the hole and wedged so that the top of the tubing is at 3210'.

Production before work-over: Averaged for 20 days, 33 bbls. oil, 115 bbls. Water, gas 70,000 cubic feet.

Production after work-over: Flowed 38 bbls. oil, 130 bbls. water in 24 hours thru open 1/2 & 3/4" chokes with 450# gas pressure on casing, gas volume was 265,000 cu. ft.
