Gentlemen:

Our records indicate that you were advised by letter dated May 2, 1957 that the R. O. Gregory Well No. 2 in Unit L of Sec. 33, T-25-S, R-37-E which is being carried as a Langlie Mattix Pool well should actually be classified as a gas well in the Jalmat Pool, and that it would be necessary for you to apply for a non-standard unit. According to our records this has not been done, however.

This well will be removed from the Oil Proration Schedule effective March 1, 1958 and in order to obtain a gas allowable you must make application to our Santa Fe office for the non-standard proration unit, and file Form C-128 outlining the acreage to be dedicated with this office.
