This well is TA'ed and is not presently capable of producing in paying quantities as it is depleted of primary oil. This well was shut in during March, 1975 and was averaging 2.2 BOPD, 18 MCFPD, and 21 BWPD at that time. This well was shut in because it wasn't producing enough to cover operating expenses. This well should not be plugged and abandoned at this time because there is the possibility of recovering additional oil by means of secondary recovery, as this well is within 5 miles of 3 active Langlie Mattix Waterflood units. A study of the secondary recovery possibilities of this lease will be made in 1977 and the final disposition of this well will be determined by the end of 1977.
