Re: Application for Extension of the Justis Gas Pool in
Lea County, New Mexico, as Heretofore Described, to
Include the NW/4 of Section 36, T-25-S, R-37-E

Gentlemen:

By Order R-586-C dated October 3, 1957, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission revised Rule 5 of the Justis Gas Pool Rules to provide for 320-acre standard proration units to consist of between 316 and 324 contiguous surface acres, which shall be a legal half section of the U. S. Public Land Surveys. This rule further provides that the dedicated acreage must reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Justis Gas Pool.

Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of the Arnott-Ramsay "F" 320-acre lease which consists of the N/2 of Section 36, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Gulf's Arnott-Ramsay "F" Well No. 3, located in the center of the NW/4 of the NE/4 of said Section 36, is producing as the unit well of a non-standard 160-acre unit which is within the defined limits of subject pool.

In this application Gulf Oil Corporation seeks to extend the horizontal limits of the Justis Gas Pool, as now defined, to include the NW/4 of Section 36, T-25-S, R-37-E. It is respectfully requested that this matter be set for hearing at an early date.
