On May 14, 1951, PE from 3300' to 3290' with pea gravel. Placed 225 quarts SNG from 3290' to 3199'. One 24hr. Duplex bomb set for 24 hours to explode at 9:30 a.m. 15th by Rock Glycerin Co. Bolshevik cave catcher at 3194'. Crushed brick from 3197' to 3194'. Pea gravel from 3194' to 3189'. Dumped 10 sacks Calseal from 3189' to 3140' by Halliburton. Steamed to surface with water. Job Complete at 11:00 p.m. May 14, 1951.
