Water breakthrough problems are being experienced on this unit, and temperature surveys and injectivity profiles were initiated to determine the offending intervals. A liner is proposed for this well to eliminate injection into the Tubb Zone and the upper portion of the Brinkard Zone.

Well was shut in on June 9, 1971, and we propose leaving it shut in until remedial work permits correction of the injection interval.

Instructions
