FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

In order to increase production we propose to do the following work:

1. Perforate seven inch casing with four jet shots per foot in the following intervals: 3622'-3636', 3640'-3650', 3654'-3663'.
2. Fracture perforated intervals from 3622' to 3663' and open hole interval from 3666' to 3760', down the casing with 20,000 gallons of refined oil and 30,000 pounds of sand, employing temporary plugging material & adomite. Overflush with 15 barrels lease crude. Shut well in to stabilize.
3. Clean out to total depth if necessary.
4. Swab, test, and return well to production.
