DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On September 29, 1952 at 1:00 P. M. 48 hours had elapsed since running 3126' of new 9 5/8" casing. Landed at 3139' and cemented in two stages as follows: 1st stage cemented with 200 sacks neat cement. 2nd cemented through staging tool set at 1203' with 150 sacks neat cement. (Temperature survey indicated good cement at 900'). Casing shut off was tested with 1050 psi for 30 minutes before and 950 psi after drilling staging tool and 850 psi for 30 minutes after drilling shoe. Since there was no appreciable drop in pressure on any test, drilling operations were resumed. Well was spudded 9/16/52.
